Voices from government, industry, and education have argued that, in order to equip the next generation for life and work in the decades ahead, it is vital to support maker-centered learning in various educational environments. Maker-Centered Learning provides insight into what "Maker-centered" means, and offers tools and knowledge that can be applied anywhere learning, propelled by social interaction, takes place. This course will explore key principles to encourage educators to focus on strategies which strengthen student responsiveness to learning stimuli. The course outlines several specific strategies, classroom examples, teaching and learning tips, and discussion questions. All teachers, counselors, coaches, mentors, and administrators will find new perspectives and ideas for their own practice as educators seeking to bring the profession into the 21st century.
