Dr. Dweck has coined the term "growth mindset" which challenges the traditional concept that student academic achievement is primarily based on fixed prior abilities. According to Dr. Dweck, "effort, perseverance, resiliency and purposeful engagement" is the hallmark of a growth mindset which can stretch a student's potential, shift motivation and ultimately affect academic performance. This course is designed to provide educators with information, strategies and resources on the important components of a "growth mindset learning environment" (Dweck 2015) in their classrooms.
